- Those who have responsibility for construction workers/contractors outside the UK.

### Assessment

Units IGC1 and ICC1 of the NEBOSH International Certificate are each assessed by a two-hour written examination. Unit ICC2 is assessed by a practical assessment carried out at a construction site.

# Exemptions

If you have been awarded the NEBOSH National <u>General</u> or <u>Fire</u> Certificate in the last 5 years you will be exempt from Unit IGC1 and can simply 'top up' by completing Unit ICC1 and the practical assessment (Unit ICC2).
